




Background

What's the plan?


Street, sidewalk, and driveways

 Install a sidewalk bridge across the concrete flume




Street, sidewalk, and driveways

- Lower and reconstruct Contessa from just North of Colwyn Pass to the cul de sac



Street, sidewalk, and driveways

- Install a sidewalk bridge across the concrete flume
- Lower and reconstruct Contessa from just North of Colwyn Pass to the cul de sac
- Mill and overlay Contessa from Downshire Drive to just North of Colwyn Pass
- Replace curbs, sidewalks, and driveways, as needed

Mail service


 Mailboxes will be removed and a temporary community mailbox will be set up.




Solid Waste service
